New Features and Enhancements

This release introduces the following new features and enhancements:

WAN Up/Down Events: HiveOS 6.9r2 reports WAN interface up/down events, which contain the following information:

- Interface ID
- WAN Priority
- Reason Codes
- Event Timestamps

Tunnel Up/Down Events: HiveOS also 6.9r2 reports tunnel up/down events, which contain the following information:

- Tunnel ID
- VPN Throughput Per Tunnel
- Reason Codes
- Event Timestamps

Important Considerations

You can upgrade VGVA (VPN Gateway Virtual Appliance) directly from HiveOS 6.9r1 to 6.9r2. Upgrading from an early version requires a new deployment of the VGVA; in-place upgrades from previous versions of HiveOS are not supported.
